Section 36 Consent: Condition 20, ‘Air Defence Radar Mitigation Scheme (“ADRMS”)’

On 30th July 2018 Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (“MS-LOT”) received a letter from the Ministry of Defence (“MoD”) confirming that the mitigation agreed with Kincardine Offshore Wind Limited (“KOWL”) under a Contribution Agreement (as amended by the Accession Deed) satisfies the section 36 Consent (“s.36”) in so far as it relates to the requirement for an Air Defence Radar Mitigation Scheme (“ADRMS”) as specified in Condition 20 of the s.36.

The MoD, in their response concluded that subject to the wind farm being designed, developed, constructed and operated within the modelling parameters set out in the Contribution Agreement as agreed between KOWL, MoD and other relevant developers, that an upgrade of the existing radar to a Lockheed Martin TPS77 radar would overcome the adverse impact of the Development on the air defence radar at RAF Buchan.

MS-LOT on behalf of the Scottish Ministers, is satisfied that the requirements of condition 20 of the section 36 consent have been met. This approval is subject to Kincardine Offshore Windfarm Limited’s compliance with the terms of the Contribution Agreement.
