

**KINCARDINE OFFSHORE WINDFARM LIMITED**

**NOTIFICATION OF DECISION**

**THE ELECTRICITY GENERATING STATIONS (APPLICATIONS FOR VARIATION OF  
CONSENT) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2013 (AS AMENDED)**

Further to the notice that Kincardine Offshore Windfarm Limited (“KOWL”), registered under company registration 475345 at 20 Castle Terrace Edinburgh EH1 2EN, applied to the Scottish Ministers under section 36C of the Electricity Act 1989 to vary the consent granted on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2017 under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to construct and operate an offshore generating station at a site 15 km offshore south east of Aberdeen with a total area of 110 km<sup>2</sup> (**57°00.000’N 01°50.000’W (WGS84)**).

Notice is hereby given that the **KOWL** has been **granted**:

- variation of consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989.

The section 36 consent has been varied to allow; a change in turbine rated capacity from 6 to 8 MW to up to 8.4 MW (ensuring that the maximum generation capacity does not exceed 50MW); a change in the maximum turbine hub height from 100 meters measured from LAT to 105 meters measured from LAT and consequential variation to the wind turbine blade length, tip height, rotor diameter, blade width and rotation speed.
